Student Right-to-Know Rates

The **Student Right-to-Know four-year average completion or graduation rate** for students who entered as full-time, first-year, degree-seeking students is 57%. This is based on the total number of students who entered the University in the fall terms 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 (n=5,262) as full time, first year, associate or bachelor degree-seeking, undergraduate students who earned their degree at the University within six years of entering the University of Hartford (n=3,009).

The **Student Right-to-Know four-year average transfer-out rate** for students who entered as full-time, first-year, degree-seeking students is 32%. This is based on the total number of students who entered the University in the fall terms 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 (n=5,262) as full time, first year, associate or bachelor degree-seeking, undergraduate students who did not earn their degree at the University and who were known to have transferred to another institution (n=1,699).
