What is my responsibility and role under Title IX?

Confidential Resources:

Sometimes, when a person experiences sexual violence, they want to get advice from someone who is not required to report their conversation and can keep the details of their experience confidential. At the University of Hartford, this includes:

- Any clinician or therapist with Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS).
- Any health care provider at Health Services/Hartford Health Care
- Any clergy with Campus Ministries

Responsible Employees:

All other University of Hartford faculty and staff are understood to be "responsible employees." This means they are required by university policy and state and federal guidance to report any incident. If you know someone who has experienced sexual misconduct of any kind, you are required to connect the individual to the Title IX Officer or Deputy Title IX Officer.
